


Think Outside the Lockbox

Know Your Options for Storing and Sharing Your Family Plans



If it's written down, make sure they store that information securely.




Plan who will notify your loved ones (and how) when the time comes.

Path 2: Cloud




If you already store and share information on a cloud drive, you may choose this option as an easier way for loved ones to access your family plans.




Upload your will, financial statements and other important documents.

Share access to your information.

Fewer people with access reduces the likelihood of a breach.



Make sure passwords are strong and safely stored.

Your information is still vulnerable in most cloud environments, even with a strong password.




Plan who will notify your loved ones (and how) when the time comes.


Designate recipients for each vault and create unique passphrases for each recipient.

Designate delegates for your vaults.


Grant loved ones or estate planners access to view and update your information in one or more vaults.
