

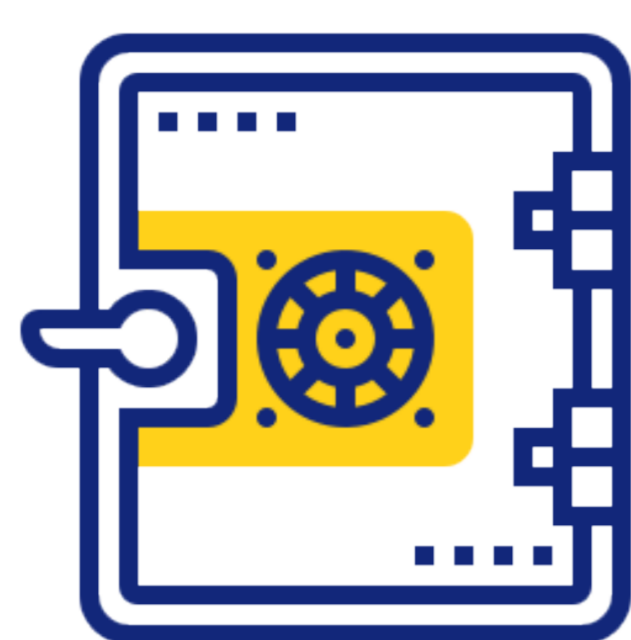
Think Outside the Lockbox

Path 1: Lockbox

<p>Upload your will, financial statements and other important documents.</p> <p>If you use your cloud regularly for large file storage, keep in mind that storage space may be limited.</p>	<p>Share access to your information.</p> <p>Fewer people with access reduces the likelihood of a breach.</p>	<p>Make sure passwords are strong and safely stored.</p> <p>Your information is still vulnerable in most cloud environments, even with a strong password.</p>	<p>Plan who will notify your loved ones (and how) when the time comes.</p> <p>As with the lockbox option, make sure this information is accessible when needed.</p>
